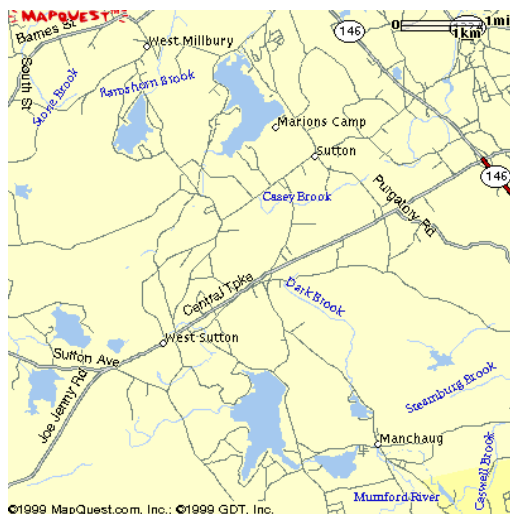

THE PLAYERS CAMP PROGRAM

Training sessions encourage progressive development of each player. The camp is structured to meet the individual player's needs based on size, age, ability and playing experience.

DAILY SCHEDULE

- 9:00 to 10:45 Technical Training
 - 10:45 to 12:00 Small sided & skill games
 - 12:00 to 12:30 Lunch
 - 12:30 to 2:30 Tactical Training
 - 2:30 to 3:15 Organized Large-sided Instructional Games
 - 3:15 to 3:30 Warm-downs & Announcements

- Monday: Theory, practice of shooting & kicking stationary and moving ball (crossed ball)
 - Tuesday: Trapping, passing, receiving, drawing in, chipping, slotting, and controlled chip
 - Wednesday: Tricks & moves, "Fluney" crouch & jockeying defense, tackling, shielding the ball
Camp Challenge: Offensive & Defensive players compete one vs. one
 - Thursday: Volley, half-volley, turn & volley, shooting & deflection, lobbing the keeper, penalty kicking, Final Competition in the Ten Skills Games (groupings determined by age)
 - Friday: Defense & Offense in the Box on corners, free-kicks & throw-ins, Offensive & Defensive tactics, Coaches (& parents ?) versus Campers, Camp Cookout, Final Awards Ceremony & Evaluations

(Schedule may be altered due to inclement weather or at the discretion of the Director)

(During inclement weather the camp will move to indoor facilities, specific information provided at sign-in.)

PREMIER CAMP**

Premier Camp is available when U12 or older MAPLE team of 8 or more players come for the same week.

GOALKEEPER TRAINING PROGRAM

Program emphasizes separate, specialized, skills training sessions for goalkeepers including catching & diving for shots of different height and power, catching in a crowd: fielding crossed balls, tipping over & around: keeper-kicking. Keepers integrated into field player sessions to improve decision making & reading of real-game situations, e.g. breakaways & angles, dealing with pass-backs controlling the box; initiating offense.

Full day keeper program: July 9-13 August 6-10

Half day keeper program: July 9-13 August 6-10

TUITION & REFUNDS

Tuition costs: Players camp \$225. Ball and two T-shirts included.

A non-refundable \$100 registration fee must accompany the application (deducted from the tuition). Refunds of registration fee returned to those excluded by enrollment limits.

Tuition balance refundable if your child cannot attend camp & if the camp is informed at least two weeks before camp starts. No refunds for early departures.

Player Discounts: Two week camp special \$400. Three week camp special \$575. \$25 discount for each additional child enrolled in camp.

Team Discount: Any team with 10 or more players attending camp during the same week receives a discount of \$25 per player. A copy of team roster is required for teams not affiliated with the Fuller Hamlets Soccer Club. Applications must be submitted at the same time.

Only one discount per player allowed.
